



Ines left behind a unique legacy when she died: 10 books with the inscription "For my children". They contained the story of her life. In the 1920s, Ines married a violent and unfaithful man who liked to father children but not care for them. They had 20 children in total.

La historia invisible The Invisible Story DIRECTOR Claudio Remedi

The conquest of the Argentine desert was a violent military campaign that took place in the 1870s and 1880s. Its aim was to subjugate and displace the indigenous Mapuches who lived in Patagonia, a vast region in southern Argentina and Chile. The campaign resulted in a silent wound on the Mapuche culture and identity that still affects them today.



La selva inflada The Inflated Jungle DIRECTOR Alejandro Naranjo

An investigation into a mysterious and alarming phenomenon in the Colombian Amazon: a wave of suicides among the young indigenous people. It also traces the history of how the white man's invasion of the jungle disrupted the natural and ancestral harmony of the Amazonian tribes.





She was a student of the Peruvian philosopher José Carlos Mariátegui and a lover and muse of the Mexican muralist David Alfaro Sigueiros.
